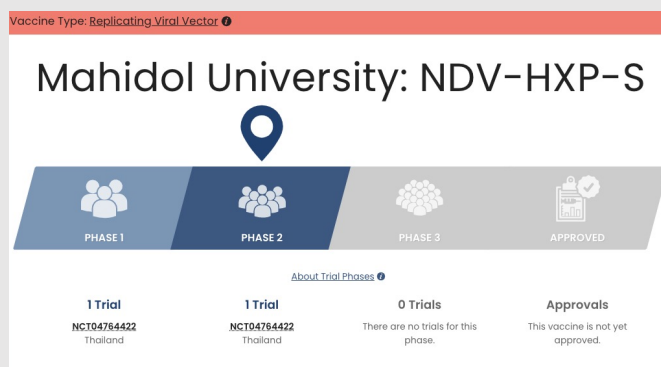

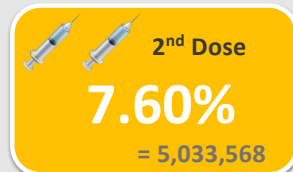
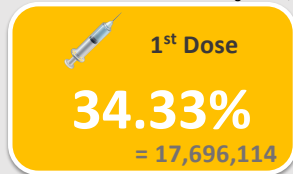

Recommendations on COVID-19 Vaccine Access and Information for Key Populations

- The vaccination registration system should be improved;
- The government should study strategies from other countries that have reached higher vaccination rates;
- The government should provide a broader variety of vaccines. The currently available vaccines appear to be of lower quality and efficiency;
- Most importantly, vaccines should be accessible and be provided to all people living in Thailand.
